Shop & Share is a one-day event at grocery stores across Kentucky to support domestic violence shelters.

You can “shop” for what you need and “share” a few items with your local domestic violence shelter. Donations collected at Kroger locations in central Kentucky will benefit GreenHouse17, the nonprofit organization that operates the region’s 42-bed emergency shelter for survivors of domestic violence and their children.

The shopping list for GreenHouse17 includes Kroger gift cards, canned foods, shelf-stable milks, toilet paper, diapers, and more. Look for volunteers at the doors of more than 20 Kroger locations in the region from 9 am to 5 pm on the day of the event.

“This is one of our most important days for our shelter,” explains Darlene Thomas, executive director. “In just a few hours, generous shoppers donate enough supplies to stock our pantry for almost a year.”

The day would not be possible without the support of more than 200 volunteers—collecting donations at stores and transporting them to the shelter facility for storage.

Shop & Share is organized by Kentucky First Lady Brittainy Beshear and ZeroV, the state coalition of domestic violence programs, in partnership with Kroger, Food City, IGA, and Super Dollar stores. The effort was begun many years ago by former First Lady Jane Beshear.
